This is done by way of analysis and comparison of theories and ideologies pertaining to State Law. This course is a foundation for subsequent courses in State Law such as Constitutional Law, Administrative Law and International Law.
2	Law	Law	Bachelor	LWHD610004	The Law and Society	3	2.100 Minutes	Odd Semester	Depok	This course studies law as a non-autonomic field, taking into account how the external factors - such as social, cultural and economic - influenced the way the law works. The power of social drive in the law area reflects the need for comprehensive understanding on law as a social construction mechanism.
3	Law	Law	Bachelor	LWPE610105	The Law of Property	2	1.400 Minutes	Odd Semester	Depok	This course explains Property Law, which was governed by the Chapter II of the Indonesian Civil Code as well as its security, which is governed by the Civil Code and other relevant laws.

4	Law	Law	Bachelor	LWPE610011	The Law of Obligation	3	2.100 Minutes	Odd Semester	Depok	This course discusses a wide range of issues on Contract and Specific Transactions in Contract, such as the structure and classification of Chapter III of the Indonesian Civil Code, definition of contract, sources and types of contracts, performance and non-performance of contract, force majeure, remedies, Torts and termination of contracts. In addition, this course also covers Special Agreements - both governed by the Civil Code and other relevant laws - which include transactions such as sales, barter, leases, grants, bailment, right to use, loans, granting of power and assumption.
5	Law	Law	Bachelor	LWAN610010	The Principles of Administrative Law	3	2.100 Minutes	Odd Semester	Depok	This course discusses history and development of Administrative Law in Indonesia; nation, law and government; where Administrative Law stands in the Indonesian legal system and its connection with public law, private law and social context; description of Administrative Law, power and sources of Administrative Law (formal and material sources). Further, the course will examine basis of authority (e.g. ascription, delegation and mandate); limitation of power (doelmatigheid, rechtsmatigheid, wetmatigheid, AUPB and Good Governance); discretion, governmental actions and product of its actions. It will also touch on the issues such as governmental agencies; government tools such as acts/laws and beleidsregel; people's rights to be protected, preventive, repressive, Administrative Court; human resources aspect of government; national and local budgeting system (APBN and APBD); state asset and local government asset; sources and management of state funding; tax as state's income; and, lastly, monitoring and administrative sanctions.
6	Law	Law	Bachelor	LWET610012	The Intellectual Property Rights	2	1.400 Minutes	Odd Semester	Depok	This course studies Intellectual Property Rights, which cover Copyrights, Patents, Industrial Designs, Trade Secrets, Trademarks, Layout Design of Integrated Circuits, Plant Variety Protection Rights, Protection of Geographical Indication at international and national levels.

7	Law	Law	Bachelor	LWAC610023	The Law on Constitutional Court Procedure	2	2,100 Minutes	Odd Semester	Depok	This course, which is a branch of Administrative Law, discusses the procedures of Indonesia's Constitutional Court. The course examines cases and disputes tried at the Court and looks at theories, concepts and laws applicable to the Constitutional Court. Moreover, the course reviews the aspects and general principles of the Court procedures; procedural review of acts/statutes in the context of constitution, settlements of disputes pertaining to institutions whose authority derived from the constitution; procedures for dismantling political parties; procedures concerning disputes over election results. Further, the course studies the procedures for reviewing parliament's opinion when the President and/or Vice President is deemed to have violated the laws, as well as when President and/or Vice President is deemed to have failed in carrying out their duties and responsibilities as President and/or Vice President of the country. Students will have the opportunity to practice each set of cases in mock trials.

The basic understanding of and main issues found in Public International Law will also be discussed in this course. Furthermore, legal basis, source of laws, international treaties, national zones, jurisdiction, and state responsibilities will also be examined.
10	Law	Law	Bachelor	LWIN611004	The International Business Transaction	2	1.400 Minutes	Odd Semester	Depok	This course discusses the background, scope, transnational cases within the span of International Business Transactions (IBT) including roles and liabilities of parties involved in these commercial transactions. Further, the course will discuss the application of theories found in Private International Law in IBT cases. This course explains, identifies and analyzes actual cases, occurred both in Indonesia and in other parts of the globe, and legal relationships stemmed from IBT.

11	Law	Law	Bachelor	LWET610150	The Commercial Paper Law	2	1.400 Minutes	Odd Semester	Depok	This course covers commercial papers or negotiable instruments, documents known as waarde papieren in Dutch, which are considered as payment devices. The documents have special legal status that enables them to flow freely through commercial networks. Negotiable instruments can be used for both credit and payment purposes. For example, a promissory note evidencing a promise to repay money owed is a credit instrument. A check written to pay dues is a payment instrument. The main legal bases of these Commercial Papers are the Indonesian Commercial Code and several laws related to certain types of commercial paper issued by the Bank of Indonesia (Indonesia Central Bank).

The second part of the course studies the definition of Space, state jurisdiction in Space, important aspects covered in Space Treaty of 1967, and conventions on space exploration activities.

Particularly, the course examines different forms of marriages and their legal implications on the spousal relationship; parent and child relationship; marital assets; different types of family structures in the indigenous society and other miscellaneous legal aspects. In wills, the course will examine benefactors and beneficiaries in wills; different types of wills; Preferred and Substitute Beneficiaries and Beneficiaries' Portions; gift and testamentary gift (hibah wasiat); as well as the development and recent changes in the law of marriage, family and wills - according to Indonesian Adat law.

The course explains the inception of such law, characteristics and values, and compares it with other laws (Western and National Laws). It also discusses land law and contract law stemmed from these adat laws, as well as the basis and validity of the law, its role and position in the National Law framework, and lastly, its development and modifications nowadays.

It also elucidates personallaw, family law and wills in accordance with theories and provisions governed by the Indonesian Civil Code and other relevant laws.

In addition, issues such as legal philosophy and labor law paradigms from normative perspective will also be discussed - with emphasis given on Labor Mobilization and Utilization, Work Relations and Labor Relations, Health and Workers Safety, Social Security of Labor Force, Dispute Settlement and Termination of Employment.

For instance, in authority, the following components will be discussed: source of authority; type and degree of authority; persons with authority; relevant organizations and their operations; personnel, finance and assets; monitoring and training. The relevant sectors that will be discussed are: Land Office, Labor, Environment, Tax, Local Governments, Development Administration as well as Organizational Structures/Law of Bureaucracy and Human Resources.
24	Law	Law	Bachelor	LWAN610018	The Agrarian Law	3	2.100 Minutes	Even Semester	Depok	This course describes Agrarian Law/Land Law/Real Property Law, which is distinct from Personal Property Law that covers transactions of movable goods, in a narrow context. It covers a set of laws that govern ownership of land in Indonesia, codified in Law No. 5 of 1960 on Basic Agrarian Law Act, and other sets of law supporting the implementation of this Act that pertain to land transactions. This course discusses the description and scope of Agrarian Law in a broad sense as well as in a narrow sense; various types of land ownership in Indonesia and its regulations prior to and after the codification of the Agrarian Act in 1960. It also observes the inception of Agrarian Law Act and progress in land transactions in Indonesia; types of ownerships as referred to national land law; land reforms in Indonesia; land acquisitions for the purpose of national development; land registration; land as debt collateral (mortgage); and ownership of condominiums/apartments in Indonesia.
25	Law	Law	Bachelor	LWET610013	The Principles of Commercial Law	3	2,100 Minutes	Even Semester	Depok	This course analyzes legal issues arising from commercial transactions. This main course of Commercial Law covers various agreements in which corporation acts as a legal entity, miscellaneous types of corporations, agents/intermediaries and commercial papers as a form of payment. In addition, relevant laws governing commercial transactions, such as Commercial Code and Civil Code, and their application will also be discussed.

Several important developments in the Law of the Sea - starting from the era prior to the codification of law, to the Geneva Convention in 1958, and the Law of the Sea Convention in 1982 - would also be examined. In addition, the course also discusses issues such as maritime zone, rights and obligations of coastal nations and foreign vessels, various jurisdictions applied in the seas and settlement of disputes arising from the use of the sea, and, lastly, the application of the Law of the Sea by a number of countries including Indonesia.

Further, the course will also look into philosophical doctrines such as doctrine of fate, legal positivism, Kelsenian doctrine, sociology of law, realism, history of law, court system, and Pancasila as harmonization pillars of legal norms.

Furthermore, the course discusses the organizational aspect of environment, both in national and local levels, their authorities, responsibilities, roles in environmental planning and conducting strategic environmental assessment. The discussion will be followed by examination of planning instruments such as command and control approach, economic and voluntary approach. Moreover, entitlement and claim, including claim settlements, both in court and other venues, will also be examined in relation to the enforcement of the three legal areas involved (i.e. criminal, civil and administrative laws). Lastly, the course analyzes actual cases derived from rative sanctions.</p>
