<p>How to Find an Academic Supervisor at Tokyo Tech</p>	<p>Applicants are required to contact a desired academic supervisor directly, and obtain approval before applying for the program.</p> <p>*Applicants for the Department of Architecture and Building Engineering are required to submit their CV and portfolio via the online application system. As academic supervisors will be arranged by Tokyo Tech, applicants are not allowed to contact potential supervisors directly.</p> <p>*Applicants for the Department of Innovation Science should contact the International Student Exchange Division in advance.</p>	<p>Applicants are required to contact an ACAP Specialized faculty member by referring to the list provided by Tokyo Tech within a set period of time. However, some Departments with many applicants may exceed their limit and will not accept any.</p> <p>*Applicants for the Department of Architecture and Building Engineering are required to submit their CV and portfolio via the online application system. As academic supervisors will be arranged by Tokyo Tech, applicants are not allowed to contact potential supervisors directly.</p> <p>*Applicants for the Department of Innovation Science should contact the International Student Exchange Division in advance.</p>
